

SMALL GRANTS PROGRAMME

- COUNTRY ELIGIBILITY -

Activities under the Small Grants Programme (SGP) shall only take place and being submitted by the countries that meet required eligibility criteria, as stated in UNEP/CMS/Conf.10.43.

To be eligible for the CMS Small Grants Programme, countries submitting a proposal must:

- 1. Have ratified CMS
- 2. Be below 0,200 in the UN Scale of Assessment (see Table A in the next page)
- **3.** Be not more than three years in arrears with their contributions (UNEP/CMS/Conf.10.43).
- 4. If Parties more than three years in arrears pay their dues by the submission deadline for applications (30 November 2013), they will be eligible.
